



# Case Study Runbook\*

- **Goal** – the product is useful, widely used, & worth considering.
- **Who** – why they are normal, not a one-off weirdo, “just like us.”
- **Speeds & feeds** – magnitude, impressive performance.
- **Business outcomes** – why/how it helps the organizations, usually apps.
- **Generalization** – “this is just one story of 1,000’s.”
- **Hook** – a story or astounding statement, something memorable.
- **CTA**– try it, move to the next stage of persuasion, etc.\*

\* Focused on users & buyers, also useful for influencers, investors, employees, & interneecine corporate cultures.



- Handles daily load, “market-storms.”






